"Trade for Good": Swissquote donates 236'087 CHF to Caritas Switzerland

"Just as small businesses run into liquidity problems, many families at risk of poverty also lack the money to pay their bills at the end of the month. There is no credit guaranteed by the Department of Finance for them. Families and single people with low wages and supplemental income are the first to suffer from the crisis. The poorest are hit hard," explains Hugo Fasel, Director of Caritas Switzerland. "Thanks to donations from companies such as Swissquote, but also from private individuals, we can support these people quickly and unbureaucratically," Fasel continues.

Together with the network of regional Caritas organisations, Caritas Switzerland is committed to helping people affected by poverty in rich Switzerland: families, single parents, unemployed, working poor. Caritas Switzerland is an independent association based in Lucerne. The relief organisation is Zewo certified and a member of the international Caritas network. This comprises organisations in 165 countries worldwide.
